Race Day Logistics

Parking

Free Parking is available in Parking Lot G, just south of Bessie Coleman Dr & Zemke Rd. Shuttle service will run every 10-15 minutes from Parking Lot G to the event site. It is a 20 minute shuttle ride (Map), so **ARRIVE EARLY**.

Premier Parking (\$7 pass) is located adjacent to the event site (610 O'Hare Cargo Area Rd). Parking attendants will direct cars to lots. Please display parking pass on dashboard. ****Your parking pass will be included with your race materials at packet pick-ups****

Public Transportation

Take Pace Bus 332 from Rosemont CTA station to Delta Cargo Stop . Click [here](#) for bus schedule, map, and fare info.

Strollers

Jogging strollers are allowed but are subject to search. We recommend bringing as little on the stroller as possible.

Dogs

Dogs are prohibited from running the race, but are welcome (on a leash) at the Community Day Event.

Spectators

Only registered runners will be allowed on the course during the race. However, all are invited to cheer on the runners at the Start and Finish Lines located just north of the main event site.

Take -Off Trot (4-10 years of age)

This year's Take-Off Trot will take place on the runway! Children **MUST** be registered in order to participate in the race. Each registered child may be accompanied by up to two guests onto the runway, using the two "guest" passes on the child's runner bib. Take-Off Trot runners and their "guests" will take a trolley onto the runway from the Community Day. **Trolleys will leave the Community Day promptly at 9:15am.**

Community Day Runway Access – Photo on The Runway

There will be trolleys running between “Community Day” and the runway for a photo-op from 10:00AM until 12:00PM (the last trolley will leave the Community Day at 11:45am). Runners must display race bib to be allowed on the runway. Those without runner bibs present a valid government issued ID before runway access is allowed. For minors without a valid, government-issued ID, a parent or guardian must show his or her ID and accept liability on the minor’s behalf.

Community Day Celebration

The celebration continues after the race at Community Day being held in the United Airlines Cargo Facility parking lot with activities for the whole family! Enjoy bounce houses, activities from local Chicago institutions, food & beverages, and music from Déjà vu. Hours of the Community Day are 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM.

Security Requirements

- ONLY runners/walkers wearing a runner bib will be allowed on the course during the race.
- ONLY participants with valid government-issued ID (or those accompanied by a parent or guardian with valid state-issued ID) will be allowed to participate in the photo-opportunity on the runway (approx. times 10:00a-12:00pm).
- “Guests” of the Take-Off Trot runners MUST present valid government-issued ID before being allowed runway access.
